**E. Lease Agreement with Strategic Exceptions Professional Consulting, Inc. for Office Space at 31 S. Grove Avenue to Operate a Minority Business Development Agency (MBDA) (No cost)**

Objective: Execute a five-year lease with Strategic Exceptions Professional Consulting, Inc. for three office spaces and shared meeting areas at 31 S. Grove Avenue for the operation of a Minority Business Development Agency.
