



Parking Request Quick Guide

Parking regulations are in place to ensure safe, clear streets and timely, effective service delivery.

Changing parking laws require amending the city's municipal code. Each change to the municipal code requires city council approval. City Council approval takes approximately one month from the time a decision is reached.

Guidelines for adjusting parking regulations

Each request is reviewed on a case-by-case basis, but generally relate to improving public service delivery issues not individualized parking restrictions or feuds between neighbors.

Preference is given to broad restrictions. For example "No Parking" is preferred over "No Parking 6-8 AM and 5-7 PM." Specific regulations are difficult to enforce.

City-wide parking regulations

- No parking within 20 feet of an intersection or crosswalk
- No parking within 15 feet of a fire hydrant
- No parking within 3 feet from a residential driveway (8 feet from a commercial driveway)
